COMMITMENT TO PERFORM

- Must be enrolled and meet requirements, including attending class.
- Pre-B, Elem 1, Elem 2, will spend a portion of time rehearsing during class. Allowed up to four class absences.
- B1, B2, B3 will be called or Saturday Rehearsal from time to time. You will be notified in advance. Allowed up to three class absences.
- B4 & B5 will be required to attend Saturday Rehearsals starting **September 6th**. Auditions are on **August 16**th Allowed up to two rehearsal/class absences.
- All performers must attend their **MANDATORY DRESS REHEARSAL**. No exception.
- Missing more than the allotted number of classes/rehearsals throughout the duration of the performance season (September 1 December 12) may result in the inability to perform without any refund. Scheduling make-up for missed classes or arranging for private lessons to catch up on what was missed *at the dancer's expense* (\$40 per 30-minute lesson) may be an option.
- Pre-Ballet and Elementary 1 students taking more than one class weekly will choose one class to perform with.
- Performance fees \$145 for pre ballet-Ballet 3. \$85 contemporary. Ballet 4/5 and leads will have additional performance fees. Costumes are rented, dancers do not keep their costumes. 1 pair of tights are included.
- Performance fees contribute in part to covering the costs that make this production possible, including
 costume purchases rehearsals, theater rental, teachers' salaries, stage and prop design, technical support,
 and administrative/staff fees.
- Volunteering ake these shows possible. We ask everyone to participate in fundraising by looking for shmow sponsors, selling program ads, etc. to maximize our fundraising potential. We also rely on our community volunteer hours to make our show and academy successful. Volunteer positions will be posted at the studio and announced via email.
