Please note this year all of the registered students in the above classes will be on autopay for the performance fees on January 19, 2026. Anyone who registers after this date will manually be added. Anyone signing up after **January 19th** will receive a **\$25 late performance fee**. Anyone unable to perform, needs to tell us in writing before autopay. All fees are non refundable, no exception.

COMMITMENT TO PERFORM

- Must be enrolled and meet requirements, including attending class.
- Please understand the need for maintaining excellent attendance. Any student who has missed too many classes may need to book private lessons (\$40 per ½ hour) or need to not perform. This is to ensure confidence, so each student is prepared to handle a live audience and have a good experience onstage.
- Scheduling make up classes for missed classes is recommended.
- Saturday rehearsals for those cast in leading roles and corps de ballet will begin February 14th.
- All performers must attend their **MANDATORY DRESS REHEARSAL**. No exception.
- Pre ballet- elementary 1 are in 1 performance. Elementary 2- may be in 2 shows (TBA) Ballet 1A, 1B are in 2 performances, all other levels are in 4 shows. Please note leading roles are double cast, each cast will perform in 2 shows.
- Pre-Ballet and Elementary 1 students taking more than one class weekly will choose one class to perform with.
- **Performance fees \$165** for pre ballet- Ballet 3. **\$95 contemporary**. Ballet 4/5 and leads will have additional performance fees and will be sent in email after auditions pending parts.
- Costumes are rented, dancers do not keep their costumes. 1 pair of tights are included.
- Performance fees contribute in part to covering the costs that make this production possible, including costume rental, rehearsals, theater time, and a small portion of production overhead. **New this year: every family will receive a video download link for all of our shows.**
- **Volunteering** make these shows possible. We ask everyone to participate in fundraising by looking for show sponsors, selling program ads, help us selling tickets, and volunteering to help during the event including backstage help, ushering, tickets, concessions, golf cart driving, event planning, prepping with costuming, costume cleaning, the list is large. Thank you for helping connect and making this large event successful and possible. We will have these signups online.
- **Commitment Contract for Dancer and Parent(s)**
We (parents and students) understand the rehearsal process leading up to Alexander Academy Performing Company's production is a commitment. We have read and will adhere to the policies regarding rehearsal attendance and participation requirements. We agree to stay updated on all performance season information on the Alexander Academy website (student only page) and on all cast and student emails. We agree to receiving emails and text to stay up to date and will check student only page and bulletin boards regularly. Please note, costumes will not be passed out if your studio account has a balance for any fundraiser, tuition, late fees, etc. **There are no refunds given.**
